Long Jin

A high definition tea with grassy freshness & liquorice undertones

Jasmine Pearl

Rich, round & deeply infused with jasmine. This green tea is long and has a velvet texture

Black Teas

St James Breakfast

Statuesque & broad, with strong finishing flavour of earth and bark

Darjeeling

Slightly stronger style than the typically light-bodied but perfumed versions

Organic Tumsong Estate 2nd Flush Darjeeling (SFTGFOP)

Sprightly, lively, sappy and refreshing, with an enticing combination of fresh grass, plant sap & fresh floral complexities. Broad finish with some grip.

Ceylon Supreme

Rich, soft & full, with an almost creamy wealth

Earl Grey Supreme

Refreshing with citrus charm, a perfectly focused classic

Black Scented Teas

Vanilla black tea

Dark vanilla notes of roundness & charm, supported by a discreet, soft but full-textured black tea base. The combination is creamy & sumptuous.

Lychee red black tea

Surprisingly sweet & soft, with lingering, lifted aromas of Asian fruits and perfumer's flowers. Baroque, decadent, irresistible.

Oolong Teas

Tie Guan Yin

Intense, pure, deep and mineral, with great sappy persistence and depth. Gently peachy fruit behind, with a perfumed, honeysuckle finish. Complex and masterful.

Da Hong Pao

Exceptionally fresh, floral and fragrant with cooling and palate cleansing finish.

Smooth, silky finish.*

*Puerh teas are teas from Yunnan that are aged for up to 50 years
in humidity and temperature controlled conditions to produce teas that have a
typically earthy, mature, smooth flavour and aroma.*

*Naturally fermented Puerh tea (also known as Raw Tea or Sheng Tea)
are left for at least 15 and up to 50 years; when ready, each cake of Puerh tea
is wrapped in tissue paper or dried bamboo leaves.*

*Puerh tea is named after Puerh city in Yunnan province, which
was once the main trading centre for teas made in the area.*

Whole Rose Buds

Light & sweet-edged perfumed with rose

Whole Chamomile Flower

*Bright with mellow floral depths, refreshingly bitter vegetal complexities
in the finish*

Whole Peppermint Leaf

Deep mint flavour with an almost oily mid-palate

Whole Lemon Verbena

Vivid and sinewy with mint like freshness & lemon zest pungency

Blackcurrant and Hibiscus

A spectrum of berry fruits, with a sweet perfumed finish
